The organization was initiated in 1999, registered in 2000 as a community based organization (CBO), 2004 as an NGO and 2006 as accompany

limited by guarantee. The organization started running the health centre since 2000. The organization and the health centre premises are located in Bulocho village, Nankokoli parish in Kagumu subcounties in kibuku district. the health centre coverage is three subcounties that are Kagumu, Bulangira and Kadama.

### Staffing

Kagumu Health has got seven full time staff and one part-time staff. The full time staff includes the clinical officer, 3 enrolled comprehensive nurses, one laboratory technician, one laboratory, one nursing

assistant, three volunteers and a visiting doctor. Currently, the district has seconded the health facility one midwife and is yet to report.

### Outputs

- The health centre has got 8 admission beds and 300-500 patients visits per month
- 15 -25 deliveries monthly
- 25-30 antenatal visits per week
- 30-40 children immunized per week
- 3-4 HIV Positive mothers identified , counseled and initiated on drugs per month
- 30 women receive short term family planning services per month
- 60 mothers tested for HIV/AIDS per week
- 5 Children receive EID services per month
